# SPCA Dog Hike UNCG Piney Lake Friday, September 27<sup>th</sup>



# **Trip Description:**

Do you love dogs? You can spend your Friday afternoon with us as we venture out to Piney Lake for a nice hike while spending time with some great pups from the local SPCA shelter. Come out and enjoy the fresh air, spend time exploring the natural world around you, and provide a great opportunity for these dogs! There will be plenty of time for everyone to relax. This trip is perfect for anyone who loves appreciating the outdoors, self-care, and wanting to escape school for a few hours on a Friday.

**Trip Cost**: Student = \$10 (\$20 for non-students)

Includes: transportation, equipment, and instruction, and snacks.

**Cancellation & Refund Policy:** You must cancel <u>10 BUSINESS DAYS PRIOR</u> to trip departure date to receive a refund, minus a \$15 cancellation fee. Any cancellation within 10 business days will receive NO refund. If Outdoor Adventures cancels the trip prior to departure, a full refund will be issued. You may transfer your funds to another trip as long as it is outside 10 business days from the trip date. No cancellation fee is applied for transfers if transferring 10 business days or more prior to trip departure.

# Requirements to Participate:

The following requirements are required for your trip. If you do not meet or complete the following requirements prior to your trip, <u>you will be removed from the trip without refund</u>. These requirements are necessary to maintain safe and enjoyable trip experiences for all group members.

- 1) You must be able to depart by 1:30PM on Friday, September 27th at Outdoor Adventures
- 2) Bring a donation Item for SPCA organization.

Outdoor Adventures trips are human powered and adventure-based, therefore, you should expect some level of physical exertion from all of our trips. It is important to consider your current level of physical fitness and any other physical or mental limitations you may have when deciding to participate in any of our activities.
